#### 1. The School Year


The school year always starts in September and finishes in July, just like the conventional school system. We try to align term dates as closely as possible with the Lincolnshire school calendar. The year is split into six terms, each of which is between 5 or 7 weeks long. The total weeks across the whole year is usually 36.


## 2. Registration

As you are new to the school, you first need to sign up to the customer portal. You can sign up directly using your phone by downloading the Thinksmart Customer app or using this link. https://thinksmartsoftwareuk.com/customer\_portal\_v2/

Once you have the app you can search for the school using our Company Code: CZPN4MW4



Then register a new account:



When you've set up your account please add your children as students (and yourself if you are an adult student). Please let me know when you have done this, and which subjects you wish to study, and I will then allocate students to the correct classes for you.

In the portal you will be able to log in at any time and see your / your child's lessons for the coming term and obtain your latest invoice plus pay it online. You can also mark an upcoming absence and keep your personal information up to date.

From time to time we will send you messages and emails directly from this system. They tend to go to junk mail regularly so please do keep an eye on this.

#### 3. Trial Lessons

All students are welcome to try out a class before they commit for the term. Please email me to book in for a trial lesson in advance.

Trial classes should be paid in advance of attending directly to the dance school account (see fees section). Please use the student's surname as a reference.

Please note that the baby and pre-primary classes fill up very quickly each term and only those who have signed up and committed for the term are guaranteed a place. Spaces are not automatically reserved for children who have had a trial until they sign up fully.

## 4. Fees (including trials)

#### **Family Discounts**

Any family that takes 5 lessons or more in total is eligible for a 10% discount. Thinksmart will calculate this automatically on your invoice.

#### Invoices:

You will receive an invoice from Thinksmart at the start of each term. You can also see your outstanding balance in the app at any time. The invoice must be paid by the Due Date.

#### Payment:

You can now pay directly via the link on the invoice using your debit card. You can also do a bank transfer.

I am also currently looking into setting up direct debit as an option for monthly payments. More info soon!

Students must attend lessons in the correct uniform for each class. In particular, all ballet students must attend class with their hair in a bun. This is an integral part of the ballet discipline and it helps the student feel the part and perform better in class.

If you are new to the school, you do not have to buy the uniform for the first class, but it should be purchased within the first term.

#### What should you study?

To be a rounded dancer it is important for students to study several different disciplines, which is why I encourage all students to study at least Ballet, Tap and Modern. As a minimum I advise that all students study ballet as this is absolutely essential for their continued progress in other subjects, in particular modern, contemporary and acrobatic arts. Students who do not study ballet almost always find it hard to keep up with their peers when they reach the higher grades due to lack of strength and understanding of postural placement.


Acrobatic Arts recommend that students should study additional dance classes (ballet) for at least 1 to 2 hours a week (up to level 3) and at least 3 to 4 hours a week (from level 4 onwards) in order to achieve their syllabus fully.

The classes also complement each other. Tap helps a student with a sense of rhythm and timing, which is essential for all dance forms. Modern theatre and ballet help each other as there are many similarities in the movements involved and they require a similar range of mobility and control. Acrobatics helps with strength and flexibility and is a huge must these days for any aspiring performer!

Finally, if a student decides later that they want to go on to vocational performing arts college, they will be expected to be able to do everything. Therefore, any students studying Musical Theatre should consider taking at least Modern classes alongside their MT lessons.

## 7. The 'Student Journey'

I created the "Student Journey" to help explain to parents and students what is available to them and how they might progress through the school from toddler to adult. I hope you find this useful!



#### 8. Examinations

Every year we enter our students for examinations in various subjects. For ballet, tap and modern we follow the ISTD syllabus (<a href="https://www.istd.org/">https://www.istd.org/</a>), for acrobatics we follow the Acrobatic Arts syllabus (<a href="https://www.acrobaticarts.com/#/welcome">https://www.acrobaticarts.com/#/welcome</a>) and for Musical Theatre we follow The Urdang Theatre and Dance syllabus.

Students usually start to take exams around the age of 5 or 6 but this depends on the subject they are studying and the exam board as they each have different entry requirements.

Students are not guaranteed to take an exam each year. The class teacher will assess a student's readiness for an exam based on their progress throughout the year which includes their ability to memorise the work and perform it accurately without our help, their behaviour in lessons and their attendance record. If your child doesn't get to take their exam in a given session, please do take my word that we have made this decision in the best interest of your child and there will be another chance just around the corner!

## 9. Performance opportunities

At the Elite Academy of Dance, our primary focus is on teaching students strong, accurate and safe technique because this is absolutely key to the health, longevity and success of any budding (and growing) dancer! Therefore, our school year is very much focused on syllabus work leading to exams (in the main genres).

That being said, performance opportunities provide an opportunity for the students to develop their confidence and stage presence and have some fun. They also give you the opportunity to see what they have learnt and how they have progressed. Therefore, in normal times we aim to do a big show once every 12 to 24 months. Please note that we do not attend stage dance festivals at this time but other schools in the area do if this is your priority.
